GGA Opening Day: Thursday, April 9. Step aside Scramble Format. Tee time: 9:30am. Coffee and donuts beforehand. Event Cost \$10 + optional cart fee and lunch. Prize pool will be augmented by GGA.

GGA Inaugural “After Noon” Tournament

Thursday, April 23rd. This is our first GGA event that starts after 12:00. It is geared towards members who might still be working or find it difficult to get away for an early morning event. The format is Team 2 Best Balls Net. Teams will be put together by the Pro Shop in an A, B, C, & D player format based on handicap index. Players will need to select their Tees when signing up for the event. Cost is \$10 per player, all of which goes into the prize pool. The prize pool will be augmented by the GGA. Carts are optional and lunch/dinner on your own. There will be Team payouts, Gross and Net payouts to low individual scores, and 2 Closest to the Pin payouts. This is a limited participation event. Only 16 spots are available. The 4 Tee times will start at 12:00. We are going off in sequential tee times, so pace of play is very important.

GGA Spring Stroke Play : Thursday, April 30. The field will be divided into two flights based on handicap index. Individual player scoring. Tee time is 9:00 am. Coffee and donuts beforehand. Cost is \$10 for prize pool, plus optional cart and lunch on your own. There will be Gross and Net payouts for winners in each flight. Prize pool will be augmented by GGA.

GGA Two-Man Stroke Play: Thursday, May 14. The field will be divided into two flights based on combined handicap index of each team. Best ball of two-man team per hole. Tee time is 9:00 am. Coffee and donuts beforehand. Cost is \$10 for prize pool, plus optional cart and lunch on your own. There will be Gross and Net payouts for winners in each flight. Prize pool will be augmented by GGA.

GGA Individual Match Play and 2-Man Team Match Play Tournaments. These are single elimination tournaments played over the course of four months- similar to the Norbeck Open. Field will be divided into two flights based on handicap index. Brackets will be formed in each flight and distributed to participants via email in May. Matches begin in June. Competitors contact one another to schedule at a time convenient to both. If a match cannot be scheduled in the month assigned in the bracket, the match may be forfeit. Lowest individual handicap in the match will be subtracted from the higher handicap(s) to determine strokes given. Sign up for either or both! \$20 Registration Fee per tournament will be charged to your account. 100% of fees collected fund the 1st and 2nd Place Pro Shop Credit pay outs for each flight, PLUS the prize pool will be augmented by GGA. Sign up by May 1. Winners get their names engraved on a plaque in the Men’s Locker Room.

Format is a scramble, with men’s, women’s and mixed foursomes divisions. It is also a great opportunity to invite guests to play Norbeck. Foursomes do not need to contain a GGA member. **GREAT VALUE EVENT.**

The GGA Member/Guest (formerly the Father/Child) event will be held on Thursday, July 23. Shotgun start at 9:00 am. Each GGA member can bring up to three guests.. Play is best ball of a twosome (member plus one guest). For prizes, if a member wins with more than one guest, each guest will be paid, but the member only will be paid once. Cost is \$90 per player for coffee/cart fees, prizes and a lunch buffet.

For a player without an official handicap index, the player’s best estimate should be used, but a maximum of 20 will be allowed. Assuming more than 30 players, the field will be broken into two flights based on the average of the two player team indices. A member playing with different partners, therefore, may be in both flights. 85% handicaps will be used. There will be closest to the pin prizes, straightest drive prize, door prizes and a 50/50 raffle. Prize pool will be augmented by GGA. **GREAT VALUE EVENT.**

GGA 2-Day Internal Ryder Cup event at **Norbeck** on August 5th and 6th. Teams will be selected by the Club Pros. Tentative first day formats are: Four Ball and Scramble; Second day formats are: Chapman and Individual match play. Cost is \$15 per day for prize pool. Carts and lunch are optional. Shotgun start at 9 am. Players can sign up for one or both days.

GGA 9-Hole Modified Stableford event is scheduled for Thursday, June 4. Cost is \$10 for prize pool. Carts and lunch are optional. Shotgun start at 9 am. There will be a team and an individual winner. Teams are created by the Pro Shop based on player handicaps. Prize pool will be augmented by GGA.

Our fun and unique **GGA 9-Hole Four Club** Challenge event is scheduled for Thursday August 27. Cost is \$10 for prize pool. Carts and lunch are optional. Shotgun start at 9 am. Sign up as two man teams. Prize pool will be augmented by GGA.

- Thursday, October 1 @ Norbeck Country Club with a Shotgun Start @ 9:00 AM Cost is \$75.
- Tuesday, October 13 @ Manor Country Club with a Shotgun Start @ 9:00 AM. Cost is \$TBD

Tentative first day formats are: Four Ball and Scramble; Second day formats are: Chapman and Individual match play. Cost includes coffee and donuts before, carts and lunch. Players can sign up for one or both days.

GGA 2-Day Ryder Cup Challenge between Norbeck Country Club and Bretton Woods will take place on:

- Thursday, August 20 @ Norbeck Country Club with a Shotgun Start @ 9:00 AM . Cost is \$75.
- Wednesday, August 26 @ Bretton Woods with a Shotgun Start @ 9:00 AM. Cost is \$TBD

Tentative first day formats are: Four Ball and Scramble; Second day formats are: Chapman and Individual match play. Cost includes coffee and donuts before, carts and lunch. Players can sign up for one or both days.

GGA Away Outing(s), as yet to be scheduled, and course(s) as yet to be determined. Tee Times start at 1PM. We are limited to 20 players - so sign up soon. Cost is \$TBD for the golf, plus \$10 cash for prizes. Prize pool will be augmented with GGA funds. Lunch and Dinner are optional.

GGA President's Cup tournament will be held on Thursday, October 15. The field will be divided into two flights based on handicap index. Individual player scoring. Tee time is 9:00 am. Coffee and donuts beforehand. Cost is \$10 for prize pool, plus optional cart and lunch on your own. There will be Gross and Net payouts for winners in each flight. Prize pool will be augmented by GGA. Winners get their names engraved on a plaque in the Men's Locker Room.

GGA Closing Day is on Thursday, October 29. This year it will be a two man, 18 hole event. The front nine format will be Pinehurst (modified alternate shot), the back nine will be a scramble. There will be straightest drive and closest to the pin competitions. Play will begin after the GGA annual meeting (approximately 10 am). Cost is \$10 per player. Coffee and donuts before the round. Cart and lunch are optional. Prize pool will be augmented by GGA. Payouts go to winners of front nine, back nine and overall. Only one payout per player.

All flighted events are dependent on large enough player field to support competition in two flights.
